#### **USAGE NOTES:**


The ultra bright LED is an electrostatic insensitive device, so static electricity and surge will damage the LED. It is required to wear a wrist-band when handling the LED. All device, equipment, machinery, desk and ground must be properly grounded.




# TYPICAL ELECTRO-OPTICAL CHARACTERISTICS CURVES





Relative Intensity (a.u)








### Forward Current VS Relative Intensity

Forward Voltage (V)


