
The ultra bright LED is an electrostatic insensitive device, so static electricity and surge will damage the LED. It is required to wear a wrist-band when handling the LED. All device, equipment, machinery, desk and ground must be properly grounded.

When using LED, it must use a protective resistor in series with DC current about 20 mA.



- 2. $\theta_{1/2}$ is the off-axis angle at which the luminous intensity is half the axial luminous intensity.




TYPICAL ELECTRO-OPTICAL CHARACTERISTICS CURVES



Forward Current (mA)






Relative Intensity VS Ambient Temp




Forward Current VS Relative Intensity


Forward Voltage (V)
